

Montecito Transportation Committee Meeting Summary  
July 25, 2017

During Transportation Committee meeting on 25 July a number of participants felt that the order of parallel projects seemed wrong. Chris Sneddon made mention that Cabrillo fix might take a dozen years, so Olive Mill and San Ysidro would probably be worked on first - assuming go ahead and funding. MA feels that City, County and Caltrans should fix the urban congestion first - Cabrillo and Olive Mill, and see whether a roundabout, or anything else, is still needed at San Ysidro - or leave that intersection alone.

Another point made was the desire that community has a voice in life-cycle of this project - meaning in defining need, desirability, and look.
